2016 Qualification Important

Please note that the qualification for Standard World and Europeans will be the end of the Autumn 2015 Qualifiers..

IMPORTANT: All sailors who are interested in entering any of the World or European Championships must enter their intention to compete on the ILCA (for World) or Eurilca (for European) Championship web site. There will be a deposit to pay. For the ISAF World Championships, see below.

AWARDING OF PLACES: At the end of qualification period the UKLA office will produce a ranking ladder and authorise ILCA/ Eurilca to send entries to those on their entry list who have qualified for a place via the UKLA ranking in that order.

CLOSING DATE: You must enter on the ILCA championship site for World Championships and the Eurilca web site for Europeans by the closing date set by ILCA and Eurilca and before the end of UKLA final qualification date, i.e. before the ranking date stated below.

EXTRA PLACES: Extra places may be offered to UKLA by ILCA/Eurilca and these will normally be awarded in ranking order provided they are received before the ILCA/Eurilca closing date and before the UKLA qualification date. Should ILCA/Eurilca issue extra places after date of qualification all sailors who have entered before the qualification date will be offered a place in ranking order, but for entries placed after the date of UKLA qualification, these places will be issued in date order of application after those who have been ranked.

Note that it is possible that, in order to prevent UKLA being financially liable for untaken places, a 'commitment procedure' may be introduced. Failure to comply with such procedure may result in no place being available even though qualification may have been achieved.

SCORES FOR NON-ATTENDANCE: Scores for 'no shows' will be given as the number of competitors on the relevant ladder plus one. [NB: In the case of the Youth Ladder, should the number of sailors on that ladder be less than the result at a Qualifier, the results not being re-scored, then the number of entries at the largest Qualifier plus 1 will be used as the score for a 'no show'.]

MEMBERSHIP: A sailor must be a member of the UK Laser Association to be entitled to a place. Any sailor who is a member of two Laser Associations must inform UKLA and the other Association, which country they intend to qualify in before the start of the UKLA Qualification series.

SPECIAL DISPENSATION OLYMPIC YEAR: "A special dispensation may be made for the nominated Olympic representative in the Standard Men's events for that representative to be given average points upon not attending a maximum of a single qualifier, provided that the reason is that the qualifier clashed with a bone fide international event or similar".
